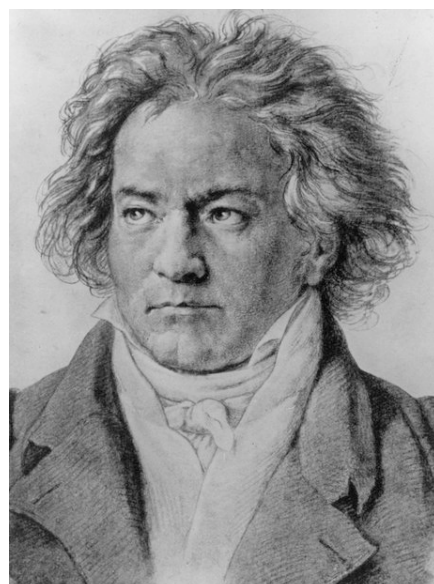

The celebrated Fifth Symphony of **Beethoven**, with its potent imagery of man's struggle against fate, changed the course of music history. Our weekend will explore the composer's development from his arrival in Vienna in 1792 until the time he created this masterpiece, some fifteen years later. Our musical examples using CD and DVD will be played on excellent hi-fi equipment.

Warbrook House is a magnificent Grade I listed mansion designed by the renowned architect John James in 1724, and set in 130 acres of Grade II listed gardens. It is conveniently located near the Berkshire-Hampshire border, and is easily accessible by train with connections from Reading, Fleet and Farnborough stations.

Terry Barfoot is Director of Arts in Residence and writes widely on music for Britain's leading journals, orchestras, festivals and record companies. He lectures at venues throughout the country and is Publications Consultant to the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra.

Gwyn Parry-Jones graduated from the Royal Northern College of Music, and played for some years with the Halle and BBC Philharmonic Orchestras. He then lectured at Reading University, leaving recently to concentrate on his musical interests, principally conducting, performing and lecturing.

Guests will arrive on Friday from 5pm, and depart after tea on Sunday. Arts in Residence and Warbrook House offer an excellent cuisine including dinner with wine, and a traditional Sunday lunch.
