Anton Bruckner was a deeply devout man, and it is not by chance that his works have been compared to cathedrals in their scale and grandeur, and in their aspiration towards the sublime. These aspects of the man and his music will be explored during our weekend, which will place particular emphasis on three of his great symphonies, with illustrations on excellent hi-fi equipment including DVD with large screen.

The **Flackley Ash Hotel** is an independently owned, family run, Georgian Country House Hotel situated on the outskirts of the historic town of Rye. The hotel, restaurant and spa facilities nestle deep in the Sussex countryside, surrounded by beautiful woodland and rolling fields.

The weekend is designed as an informal ‘house party’. Guests need only the ability to enjoy music, so no technical knowledge will be required. We will meet on Friday at 5pm and depart after tea on Sunday. Arts in Residence and the Flackley Ash Hotel offer an excellent cuisine including dinner with wine and a traditional Sunday lunch.
